GIFT FILLED SHOEBOXES: Thank you for your gift filled shoeboxes last year. They were part of 20,000 processed locally and went to Latvia, Middle East, Central Asia and Liberia. UK sent 700,000 in total to 13 countries including Eastern Europe. Over 11 million shoeboxes went worldwide to 110 countries. By doing a shoebox it is showing God's love in a tangible way to needy children and if appropriate the overseas partners will share the good news of Jesus Christ.
