SEASON OF LENT

"The Joy of Hope", is a four part video course with discussion, the course is provided by Catholic Faith Exploration and is offered to parishes to use during Lent. Stations of the Cross: there will be Stations of the Cross on **Fridays 5th**, 12th and 19th April at 18.30, you are all welcome.
