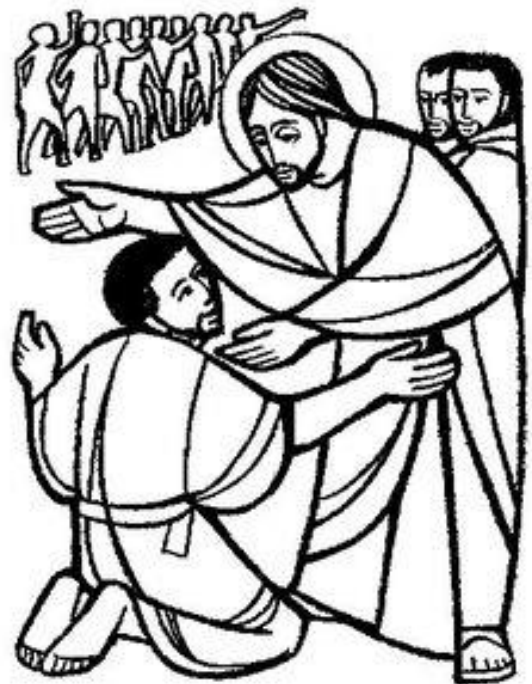
NATIONAL MASS COUNT concludes this week, it gives us some idea of the size of our parish at this time.
