CORONA VIRUS PRECAUTIONS: Bishop Alan has sent a letter outlining the precautions the Church is taking at this time to help contain the spread of the corona virus. The letter includes not using holy water at the door of the Church, omitting the sign of peace during Mass and not receiving Holy Communion from the chalice. You are also asked not to receive Holy Communion on your tongue during this time as there is a greater danger of passing on infection. Please receive Holy Communion in your hand. The priest and minister will wash their hands immediately before distributing Holy Communion.

SEASON OF LENT:

"The God who Speaks" part 2 of our Lent course continues this week on Monday 9th March with a soup lunch at 12.30 and then the session; the session is also repeated at 19.30.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament continues after Mass on Thursday, giving some quiet time of prayer.

Stations of the Cross continues on Friday evening at 18.30, following Jesus on the road to Calvary.
