**FRIDAY ABSTINENCE** from meat is dispensed this week because of the wonderful feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

**OPENING FOR PRIVATE PRAYER:** our Church is not normally open during the week for private prayer, but in the circumstances in which we find ourselves, I know some of you may wish to visit the church after so many weeks. The Church will be open on **Wednesdays from 11.00 – 13.00** and on **Sundays from 13.00 – 16.00** beginning **Wednesday 17<sup>th</sup> June** and **Sunday 21<sup>st</sup> June**. This means that you can come to pay a visit for private, silent prayer, following social distancing and using hand sanitisers which will be available. At this stage, **the toilets will not be available**. We need a few volunteers to join me in being stewards, 2 for Wednesday and 3 for Sunday, to do stay for one hour each. Please volunteer via email with a set day and time, I will talk through the role with you when you volunteer.

Entrance to the Church will via the GS Room from the back door in the garden, all doors will be open, so there should be very little you need to touch, sanitiser will be available. You are welcome to wear your own mask in the church.

This will be a small beginning, if there is greater demand, we will open the church for longer times, but more stewards will be needed.

**MIDWEEK MEDITATION:** twice a week there is a live streamed midweek meditation available for you all on YouTube/Facebook. The meditation is a short talk based on the readings of the following Sunday, to give you a thought for the day and to help you prepare for Mass on Sunday. I usually record them on Tuesday and Thursday at 10.30, you are welcome to join me live or view later.

**FIRST HOLY COMMUNION** all classes are cancelled for the time being. Please revise the book & keep this topic alive for the children, you could also use a video of one of our Masses to help the children to understand the Mass better.



**FOODBANK DONATION:** ordinarily we would have had a collection to support the foodbank last weekend, as that was not possible, I made a donation from our parish of **£100** to continue our support during this very difficult time.

**MANY THANKS** to those who have begun a Standing Order for the parish at this time, our weekly total has now gone up to **£388**, thank you for your support. Many thanks also to many of you have made donations online during this lockdown, your support is very much appreciated.
