<u>WELCOME TO MASS</u>: The changed Mass times will continue this weekend and return to normal from next weekend, 18th/19th July. Saturday evening Mass is in St Michael's this week but back in Papworth next Saturday. No need to book for Papworth, just give your name at the door.

Welcome to those joining Mass on live stream: it will be a bit different for you. The sound may be disturbed because of background noise from people in the church. At Holy Communion, I will turn off the sound and I suggest you say the two prayers for yourself during that time; I will turn the sound on again for the end of Mass.

During Mass there will be no bidding prayers, offertory procession or collection; we are asked to keep the Mass brief to reduce the amount of time people are in the church. A collection bucket will be available at each door. A printed newsletter is available, if you need it, at the end of Mass. Please touch as little as possible for your own safety and the safety of others.

Weekday Mass has now begun again, no need to book, just add your name to the list each day, sanitise your hands and put your mask on.

<u>HELP IS NEEDED</u> to enable Mass to continue, so please offer your help, ideally by email saying what you can offer, or note on your booking email.

We need 4 people to work the booking system, one to cover a whole weekend, so to do the booking once a month. You need to be good at email, but you will do this from home, answering people's booking email and allocating them a seat.

We need 4 stewards for every Mass to help & guide people as they come to Mass and to do a wipe over of the church when that Mass is finished. Anyone can do this, our younger ones can help too, as long as you are not vulnerable because of age or illness, please volunteer when you book. You do need to be here 15 minutes early to steward.

We do not have any rotas, so if you are happy to read or minister Holy Communion, please indicate this when you book for Mass.

<u>MANY THANKS</u> to all who have brought in cleaning materials for sanitising church during these times. I am very grateful to you for your generosity. We now have lots of materials, so no need to bring any more for the time being.

THANKS, FROM FR IVAN for prayers and good wishes during his recent illness. He has now finished his courses of chemotherapy and radiotherapy and has been told he is clear of cancer. This is very good news for him and he is grateful to you all for your prayers during this time and is now in very good spirits and in good health.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION a letter was sent to all parents asking how you wish to go forward for your child's First Holy Communion, so far only a few have responded. Now that we are starting to have Mass again, please let me know what you wish to do. We will need to finish the programme for those wishing to go ahead over the next few months.
