During Mass there will be no bidding prayers, offertory procession or collection; we are asked to keep the Mass brief to reduce the amount of time people are in the church. A collection bucket will be available at each door. A printed newsletter is available, if you need it, at the end of Mass. Please touch as little as possible for your own safety and the safety of others.

Weekday Mass has now begun again, no need to book, just add your name to the list each day, sanitise your hands and put your mask on.

BOOKING FOR MASS I am very grateful to the four parishioners who have volunteered to handle the booking emails, thank you. This means that I am not handling these booking emails, so it is now very important that you use the dedicated email address for booking, but that you don't use it for anything else to me, as others can now see those emails, for other matters please use stmichaelshuntingdon@yahoo.co.uk Thank you.

HELP IS NEEDED to enable Mass to continue, so please offer your help, ideally by email saying what you can offer, or note on your booking email.

We need 4 stewards for every Mass to help & guide people as they come to Mass and to do a wipe over of the church when that Mass is finished. Anyone can do this, our younger ones can help too, as long as you are not vulnerable because of age or illness, please volunteer when you book. You do need to be here 15 minutes early to steward.

We do not have any rotas, so if you are happy to read or minister Holy Communion, please indicate this when you book for Mass.

ONLINE & CONTACTLESS DONATIONS:

we have all grown used to shopping online and with contactless payments on a card, indeed, some shops now do not take cash. Our parish will soon have a window on our website for you to make easy online payments via a card if you wish. We will also have a contactless terminal in the porch for you to give your collection in that way. It will make things much easier for all of us, and much safe for the counters. The terminal will be able to deal with your Gift Aid if you wish and also with a variety of funds you may wish to support, eg Cafod, Mission Sunday, all our regular second collections.
