<u>WELCOME TO MASS</u>: Welcome to those **joining Mass** on live stream: at Holy Communion, I will turn off the sound, please say the two prayers during that time.

Procedures at Mass: just as we have all had to learn new ways of going shopping, we must also be aware of new ways of being at Mass. Please remember to sanitise your hands, to wear a mask all through Mass and to touch as little as possible in the Church. It is also important that you do not make people pass close in front of you, or try to pass close in front of others: this means either move to the other end of the pew when you arrive, or step right out of the pew for others to get in, do not make them pass in front of you, this is also true when you move for Holy Communion. Just as you would not get so close to people in a shop, please do not do it in church. Thank you.

ONLINE & CONTACTLESS DONATIONS:

We now have a contactless terminal in the porch for you to give your collection, or any other donation to our parish, in that way. It will make things much easier for all of us, and much safer for the counters. The terminal will be able to deal with your Gift Aid if you wish and eventually with a variety of funds you may wish to support, eg Cafod, Mission Sunday, all our regular second collections.

Those with Standing Orders do not need to use it for your regular donations, but may find it helpful for second collections and other gifts not covered by the standing order.

Those who use envelopes or loose cash may find it very helpful, you can use the machine instead of your envelope if you wish and still Gift Aid your payment. It may be a little slow at the beginning as Gift Aid details need to be entered, but that only has to be done once, if you use the same card each time.
