## Financial Statement, 2019

We have presented our accounts to the Diocese for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> December 2019 and anyone who wishes to view the full accounts is welcome to request a copy from Fr Philip. The following reflects the accounts accurately, but is given in more accessible form to enable you all to see the financial picture of St Michael's Parish.

At the beginning of 2019 our parish local bank account showed a credit of £3,765 and our account with the Diocese stood at £8,309, giving us a total credit of £12,074. Our closing balance in our parish account was £11,840 and at the Diocese was £25,698, giving us a total credit of £37538

Income is down by about £8,000, largely accounted for by a grant in 2018 of £6,500 from the Guild of Ransom towards the cost of renovating the house.
