**Procedures at Mass:**

- sanitise your hands at the door
- give your name to the steward
- wear a mask all through Mass
- do not leave your seat until the steward guides you to Holy Communion or to leave at the end of Mass.
- touch as little as possible in the Church
- do not make people squeeze past you, or try to squeeze past others
- step out of the pew for others to get in or out when you go for Holy Communion.

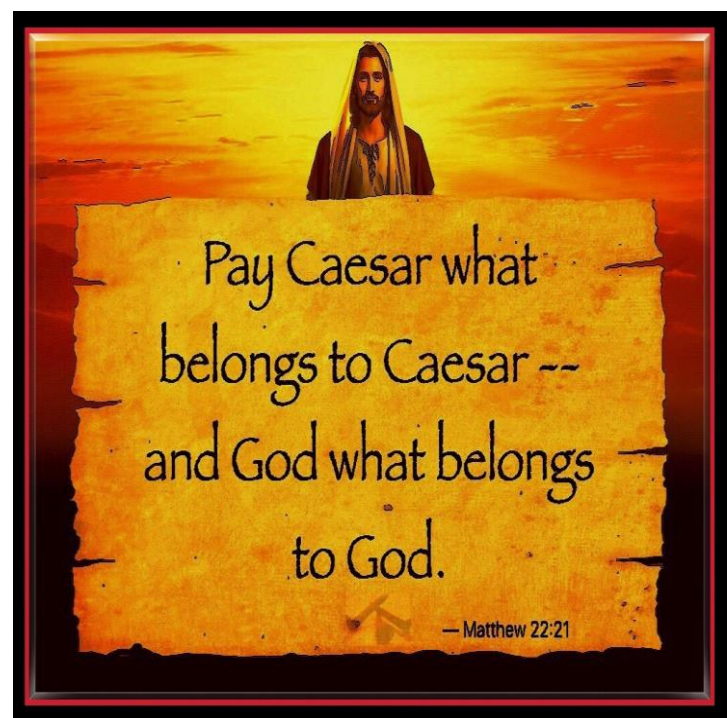
