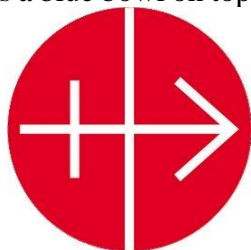
Retiring collection for CAFOD last weekend came to **£408.50**. Thank you for your generosity.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION there will a zoom meeting today at 10.00. The next meeting will be on **Sunday 28th March** via zoom at 10.00.

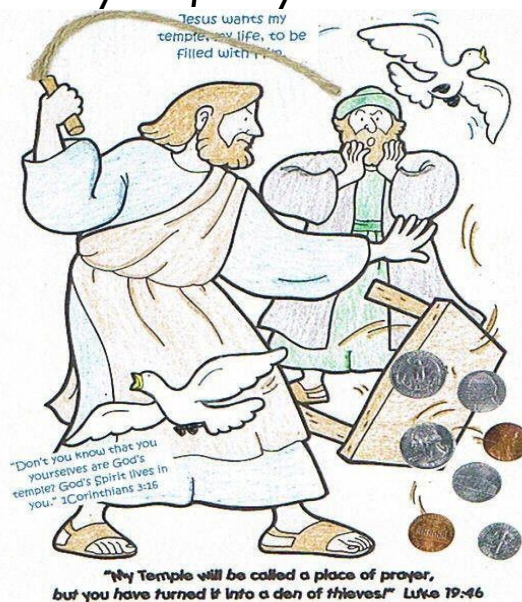
