WORLD DAY OF PRAYER FOR

ROSARY WITH POPE FRANCIS: The Holy Father has selected Shrines from across the world to participate in his special initiative to pray the Rosary during the month of May for the end of the pandemic. He himself will initiate this on May 1st and end it on May 31st. **The Shrine of Our Lady of Walsingham has been selected to participate on May 1st at 17.00.** This will be live streamed from Walsingham to the Vatican television Centre so that Pope Francis can see it live. Our particular intention is for those who have died from the pandemic across the world.

EWTN will oversee this broadcast, you can also join via the live stream from Walsingham.
