

**DAY FOR LIFE** which is to be held during the weekend of 19<sup>th</sup> / 20<sup>th</sup> June 2021. This day, inaugurated by St. John Paul II, presents an opportunity to pray for the gift of life from conception to natural death, to raise awareness of the precious gift of life, and to support the work of protecting life in its most vulnerable stages through the annual collection. **MESSAGE FROM CAFOD:** Thanks to your support, CAFOD has been helping communities around the world cope with the pandemic.
