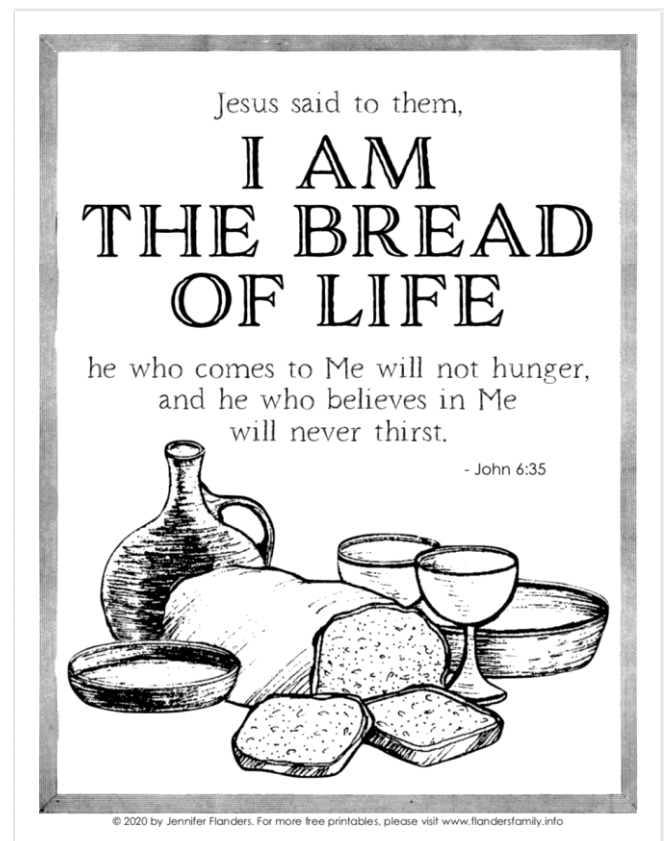
SUNDAY COLLECTION goes in the orange buckets near both of the doors of the church.
