We will continue with masks and invite you to make sure you use the sanitiser as you enter the church. We will begin the sign of peace, but in an appropriate manner, family groups may shake hands, but for others that will not be appropriate at this time. We hope to start singing again soon, but you would have to wear a mask when you are singing, this is not easy, but worth a try.

It is very important that you do not come to church if you have tested positive in recent days or have any symptoms of the virus.
