Financial Statement, 2020

We have presented our accounts to the Diocese for the year ending 31st December 2019 and anyone who wishes to view the full accounts is welcome to request a copy from Fr Philip. The following reflects the accounts accurately but is given in more accessible form to enable you all to see the financial picture of St Michael's Parish. Many thanks to Julie who prepared the parish accounts for us.

At the beginning of 2020 our parish local bank account showed a credit of **£11,840** and our account with the Diocese stood at **£25,698**, giving us a total credit of **£37,538**. Our closing balance in our parish account was **£5,030** and at the Diocese was **£171,084**, giving us a total credit of **£176,114**.

This total credit balance includes **£135,000** we received from the sale of some land in Papworth.
