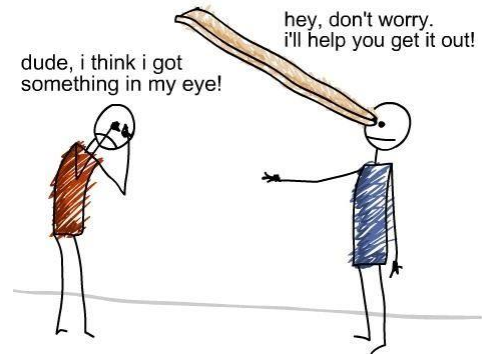
There will be some Lent books available in the porch, short readings for each day to help you with this season, please have a look and buy one.
