**UKRAINE APPEAL:** many of you have asked about how to help in this dreadful situation. I went to the Ukrainian Church in Peterborough during the week to drop off some clothes, I asked what is most needed. They would be grateful for a collection of medical items, trauma dressings, First Aid kits, sanitary items, children's milk formula and toiletries. These items are easily available to us via supermarket or online, we will have a collection of such items next weekend and I will deliver to them during the following week.

**LENT STATION MASS:** every year the Bishop visits every Deanery for a Station Mass; this is a very ancient tradition in the church. Our local Station Mass in on **Tuesday 22<sup>nd</sup> March** at Our Lady & English Martyrs in Cambridge. Exposition begins at 17.00 and Mass at 18.00 there are light refreshments after Mass.
