Holy Week

THE GREAT WEEK: we begin **Holy Week**, the great week of our salvation when we recall through our liturgy the events of the Paschal Mystery, the passion, death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. This is the high point of our faith and I hope that many of you will come and take part in the liturgy of Maundy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday.

CHRISM MASS: this Mass with the blessing of Holy Oils will be on **Tuesday 12th April** at 12.00 at St John's Cathedral in Norwich. There is a coach departing from the Cambourne church centre at 09.30, if you wish to go on it, please sign the list on the board in the GS Room. This is always a wonderful celebration.

CONFESSIONS are available as we come towards Easter; during Holy Week there will be confessions after weekday Mass or Morning Prayer and on **Wednesday 13th April** after Stations of the Cross also on Good Friday after the Services and on Saturday morning at 10.00. I hope you will be able to use these opportunities for the Sacrament.
