MISSION APPEAL: every year each parish is asked to welcome a Mission Appeal to support the missionary work of the Church. We have our appeal next weekend, **30th April/1st May**, we welcome a speaker from the Missionary Sisters of St Peter Claver to speak at all Masses and ask for your support.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION: we had a very small number of parents at the meeting on Wednesday and after a long discussion we all decided that this would not be a big enough group of young people to get the best from the programme and from the Sacrament. We decided not to run a programme this year but will begin at the beginning of January with a view to celebrating the sacrament of confirmation next summer.
