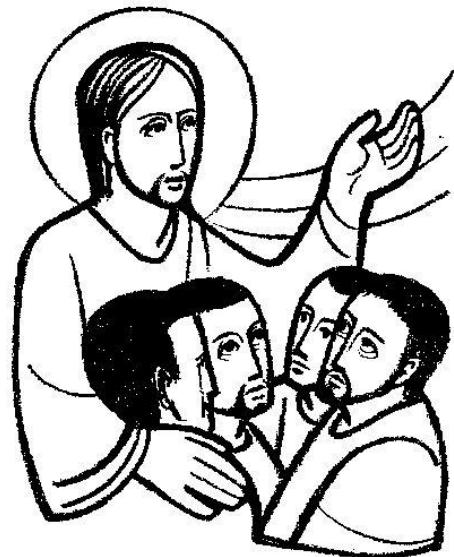
**CLEANERS THIS WEEK:** members of the Polish community on **Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> June**. Thank you.
