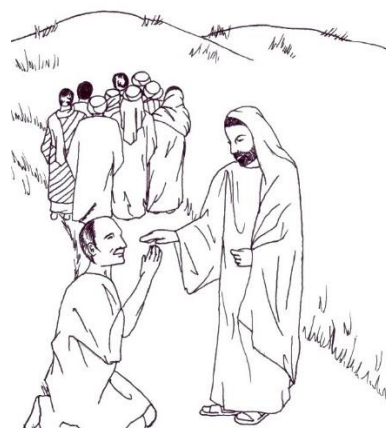
PRISONS WEEK A WEEK OF PRAYER
