The above donation brings the Building Fund to £8046.00 at the beginning of this year. This is a good total since we have not really launched our efforts yet, but many of you have felt moved to give donations as we go along. Thank you very much.

BUILDING PROJECT PROGRESS: as you know our plans are out to tender with builders who are preparing their prices to do our work; the closing date for tenders is 27th January. After that the Diocesan Trustees will consider the tenders and decide about going forward and which builder to choose to do the work. If all goes well and we get the go ahead, we should be ready to start work in the spring, perhaps late May or early June.

During last year we spent a total of £16,590 on fees and preparatory works, this brings us to an overall total of £28,700 spent on the preparation of our plans to make ready for our development project.
